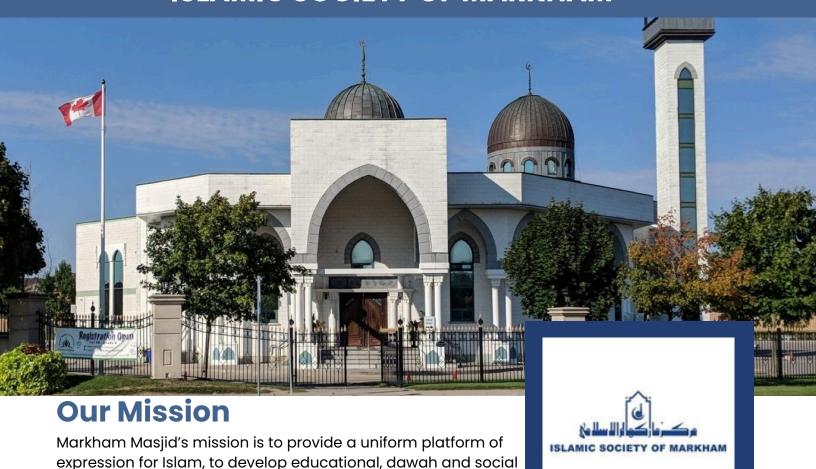

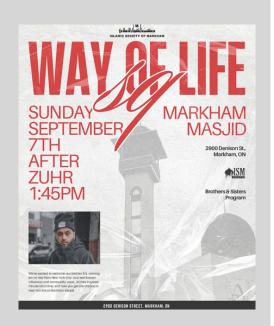


WAY OF LIFE

NEW MUSLIM SMALL CIRCLE

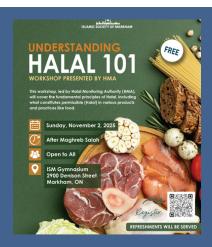
SEPTEMBER 21
